Anyone providing palliative care to the local population may apply for all or part of this award. Applications will be considered each year by a joint panel of Wellwynd Practice and St Andrews Hospice representatives. Applicants may apply for whole or part funding for professional courses, study days or team development initiatives.

Applicants must provide information on how they identified the need for training/development and how they will demonstrate improvements to local palliative care.

A total of £2000 per annum is available. Funding from this may be allocated to more than one applicant depending on the amount applied for.

Applications for the 2014 Wellwynd Educational Award should be submitted by 1st June 2014.

Completed forms should be returned to the Wellwynd Practice, Airdrie Community Health Centre, 88 Graham Street, Airdrie.

Applicants will be advised no later than 20th June 2014 if they have been successful.
